ECHO Chicago – Teen Application Process Step-by-Step Guide **June 22 – 25, 2020**

Step 1: Electronic Application Form (via GoogleForms) need to be completed.

There's one question that is part of the electronic form that asks for an essay answer format (100-200 words). This essay question can be written in advanced of submitting/completing the Electronic Form. We ask the applicant to type in their essay answer or copy/paste on to the form. Again, this essay portion can be prepared in advance of completing the electronic form. Here is the required short essay question for your consideration:

ECHO is an immersive experience into the depths of our identity as men and women through the lens of St. John Paul II's Theology of the Body. We explore themes of sexuality, vocation, prayer, and relationships. We want to make sure you want to dive in! Please tell us in 100-200 words why you want to attend Echo.

Once you have completed this step, you should receive a response from our office to continue the application process. You should then follow step two which involves the Adult/Young Adult Forms and Safe Environment Form provided on our website. You will then be notified by our office to double check if all of your forms have been completed and signed.

Step 2: Complete the Adult/Young Adult Registration and Safe Environment Form.

Download and Print All Needed Forms:

1. Teen Registration/Parent Consent Form
2. Acknowledgement of Safe Environment Form for Teens that will be 18 years of age on the dates of ECHO.

All of the above forms will be emailed to you after you register and must be downloaded, completed, scanned, and emailed as a PDF to fbernal@archchicago.org and must be downloaded, completed, scanned, and emailed as a PDF to rpingoy@archchicago.org in order for registration to be considered completed or mail your forms to:
