YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE ON APYC

In order to expand the feedback and communication base for the delegates, the Archdiocese of Chicago is in the process of selecting high school youth, three from each of the six Vicariates and three from the Polish community, to serve as *representatives* on the Archdiocesan Pastoral Youth Council (APYC). The Youth Council will gather information from peers in their parish, school, and youth group settings regarding a specific topic designated by Cardinal Cupich. This feedback and these insights are then shared with the youth delegates at the quarterly meetings.

It is very important that the young people applying are willing and able to make a consistent commitment to a quarterly meeting (likely September, November, January, March, May) held at different locations throughout the Archdiocese on Sunday afternoons from 1:00-3:00pm. It is also of utmost importance that the Vicariate APYC representatives be willing to gather and organize feedback from peers prior to the meetings.
