## Youth Ministry Leadership Development

### **Provided by the Center of Ministry Development Certificate in Youth Ministry Studies**

The Youth Ministry Leadership Development Summer Institute is a ministry education program for adults in ministry to youth in parish and school settings. It equips leaders with the knowledge, skills, practical tools, and techniques needed for creative and comprehensive ministry to youth. It is co-sponsored by the Center for Ministry Development and the Archdiocese of Chicago.

## AUDIENCE

This program is designed for adults involved professionally or as volunteers with younger (10-14) or older (14-19) adolescents in a parish or school setting. The potential audience for the program includes: coordinators of youth ministry, directors of religious education, youth ministry volunteer leaders, junior high leaders, high school campus ministers, teachers, clergy, university students and seminarians. Special intention has been made to invite youth ministers serving urban and underprivileged parishes who are helping to develop Youth Ministry programs.

- Understand and build skills in the process of individual and youth evangelization to Christ
- Vision and plan discipleship-building for the year and beyond
- Connect disciple making with appropriate and effective methodologies
- Shape, lead and form an adult team focused on youth ministry
- Advocate for teens and youth ministry within the parish
- Learn how to create a long – term sustainability in the program, team, and in the youth leadership
- Build skills in pastoral and practical problem solving

Our hope is the leaders will commit to building and revitalizing their community's youth ministry programs and learn to work together with other leaders to serve the larger Church of Chicago.
