

The National Catholic Youth Conference is November 16-18, 2017. The Archdiocese of Chicago group will be leaving Chicago for Indianapolis on Thursday, November 16 at 11 a.m., and then leaving Indianapolis to return home at 11 a.m. on Sunday, November 19.

What is the name of the venue? - Lucas Oil Stadium and Indiana Convention Center

What is the name of the hotel? - JW Marriott Downtown Indianapolis (which is connected to the Indiana Convention Center)

Do Chaperones need to take the bus or can they drive separately? They need to be with their teen participants on the bus.

How much would it be for transportation, registration, and room combined?

\$540 - Teen Participants Quad

When is the first deposit for registration due? The first deposit of \$100 is due upon registration. This can be paid by mailing in a check or by credit card on registration website.

Deposit Schedule per person:

*All deposits are transferable, but non-refundable.

First deposit - \$100 due upon registration

Second deposit - \$100 will be due by May 1, 2017

Third deposit - \$200 will be due by July 17, 2017

Final deposit - Remainder of payment/person due, with all forms uploaded to Cvent by October 6, 2017

**Online registration must be complete by October 6, 2017
