This is a two part program: a course followed by a 12-day travel seminar:

Part A *(course)*

Prior to the travel seminar, a course will introduce participants to key people, practices, and places in the Franciscan world. This course counts as either a Church History or Christian Spirituality course and runs in May: SH4002b / SH5002b *Origins of Franciscan Spirituality*, Part A. You may take Part A without going on the tourgrimage.

Part B *(travel seminar)*

On June 2, 2023, we will meet in Rome to begin a 12-day travel seminar visiting significant spiritual and historical Franciscan sites. Daily tours provide participants with an opportunity to walk in the footsteps of Francis, Clare, and many more Franciscans. When possible, we will engage with Franciscan communities living and ministering in Italy.

Trip applications must be completed by March 12, 2023.

A \$300 non-refundable deposit is due with application (deducted from total). Space is limited to 15 participants. Early applications are encouraged.

Travel Program base cost is \$2,400 based on double occupancy and includes half-board in Rome, full-board in Assisi, entrance fees, gratuities, guides, and ground transportation. Cost does not include airfare, lunch in Rome, drinks, visas, or personal expenses. Single occupancy, where possible, is an additional \$400.

To receive credit for either part A or part B, there is a \$1,452 additional fee for students taking the course for credit, \$338 for those auditing, per part. Auditors are welcome to do part A but do not have to do it to go on the trip
