A Moment of Silent Reflection

Reflection Questions

In this gospel reading, we encounter Jesus healing a leper. Moved with pity, Jesus stretched out his hand to bring about healing. Instead of listening to Jesus' request, "to tell no one," the man tells everyone about his miraculous healing and the one who heals him. Jesus retreats to deserted places to find rest. People seek Jesus from everywhere.

- Recall a time when you were in great need on the journey of your ministry. Did you ask Jesus for mercy and healing to help you with the situation? Who did Jesus send to minister to you? Where do you go to seek solace when feeling overwhelmed? Is your personal desert retreat a place to share with others?
- When have you experienced exuberant joy in your ministry? Recall a breathtaking moment that drove you to share your story with others? How do you help others recognize the awe of Jesus in everyday life?
- How do you testify as a witness of Jesus Christ to others? What makes your testimony believable? How do you remedy faith challenges?
- What are your greatest takeaways from the congress? How will you help others reignite their journey?
