The above forms must be complete and submitted to the Parish or School's Safe Environment Coordinator and handled through the parish or school level. The above forms need not be submitted to the Office of Human Dignity and Solidarity, but we ask that this Safe Environment Acknowledgement Form be filled out, signed and dated.
