Dear Friends,


Thank you for making 2016 another notable year for Amate House! It was a year of change and transition, yet we are proud of our accomplishments. During this 32nd year of service to Chicago, 25 Volunteers provided over 35,000 hours of work valued at over \$800,000 to 22 nonprofit organizations and schools.

We said goodbye to several staff members who faithfully served Amate House for many years. John Lucas retired as Executive Director in June. John was a dedicated servant to Amate House and worked for eleven years to make it a financially stable organization. Because of John's vision, Amate House now owns its homes: two on the southwest side of Chicago and a third, a donation from board member Raymond Loman, in memory of his brother, Jerry. John's legacy of financial stewardship will secure the future of the organization for years to come.

Long-time Program Director Ryan Lents took a position as the Director of the Office of Human Dignity and Solidarity in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Amate House is a ministry of this office, so we continue to work with Ryan. Alison Archer was promoted to Program Director following Ryan's departure. Development Coordinator Liv Spilotro left the organization over the summer to take a position in Advancement at DePaul University. Former Amate House Program Director Lisa Wittig returned "home" as the new Development Coordinator. Finally, alumna Deirdre Kleist took over for Becca Muder, who left her position as Program Coordinator to become a Maryknoll Lay Missioner in São Paulo, Brazil. We are grateful for all of the love the outgoing staff poured into their work at Amate House. With new leadership and staff, we are committed to building on their successes in the year to come with renewed energy. MISSION STATEMENT

Amate House, the young adult volunteer program of the Archdiocese of Chicago, fosters the transformation of its Volunteers by providing experiences of full time service to people in need, community living, and faith formation. Amate House develops future leaders for the church and world who are committed to building a more just and loving society.



TENETS

Service

Our Volunteers serve at sites in a variety of fields, including: education, health education and outreach, hunger and homelessness services, legal aid, nursing, physical therapy, and service to the elderly, youth, and immigrant populations.

Community

Each year, our Volunteers live closely as a faith-based intentional community. Our emphasis on community stems from our belief that no one stands alone – our call to service cannot be sustained if we exist in isolation.

Faith

Our Volunteers are called and challenged to take a look at and share in the richness of each other's experiences through daily conversation and weekly reflection, prayer, and discussion. Retreats are placed throughout the year to give our Volunteers a chance to reconnect with each other and reflect on their call to service.

Social Justice

By walking hand-in-hand with those in need, our Volunteers live in solidarity with those they serve and realize the need for change and reform to systems in place, rising to the challenge of becoming leaders with a focus of building a more just and loving society.

Stewardship

Living simply and developing their personal gifts and strengths give our Volunteers the chance to embrace their call to service with an intentional focus on not dwelling on what they do not have, but rather making the most out of what they do have, and relying on their community members to grow and transform with each other through patience and understanding.

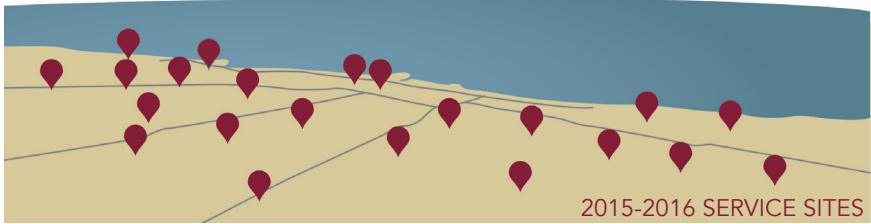

REBECCA MUDER

The first thing that strikes you about Becca when you meet her for the first time is her tremendous sense of humor and her infectious laugh. She has a way of making you feel at ease with her joyful and easy-going manner which is, in part, why she was resoundingly considered an incredible Program Coordinator and Volunteer.

Becca was an Amate House Volunteer from 2008-2010. She worked with children at Catholic Charities West Regional's SMART after school program her first year and worked at Woman Craft, a Heartland Alliance social enterprise that provided transitional jobs for women facing barriers to employment, during her second year of service. After completing her volunteer commitment, Becca received a MA in Theological Studies at the University of Dayton and returned to Amate House as a Program and Recruitment Coordinator for four years where she made her mark on Amate House programming.

Becca worked diligently to focus Amate House's volunteer formation programming on personal identity development because she felt it was important that Volunteers create a vision and mission for themselves. To facilitate this process, she created the Professional Mentor Program and organized the in-service workshop on mass incarceration. Becca was incredibly present to the communities





she coordinated and led by example. She modeled vulnerability, loyalty, and dedication to Volunteers and always graced them with humor and thoughtfulness.

During her time on staff at Amate House, Becca volunteered at Kolbe House Jail Ministry, where she participated in communion services for inmates at Cook County Jail. It was a call to live a life more radically focused on the Gospel and to accompany marginalized populations that led Becca to make the bold step to become a Maryknoll Lay Missioner in São Paulo, Brazil where she moved in January of this year. Ultimately, Becca hopes to work with families and youth to create a system of justice that focuses on rehabilitation for offenders through reconciliation with victims and the community at large. For now, Becca is concentrating on learning Portuguese and preparing for the discernment process of how her service will take shape. We have no doubt Becca's experience, her pastoral sense, and her drive to make a difference will guide her to success on this new journey and we wish her well.

The life that Becca is living embodies what Amate House formation is all about: to nurture in young adults the compassion and desire to create a more just and loving world, and to go forward from Amate House to do great things for the least of us in His name.

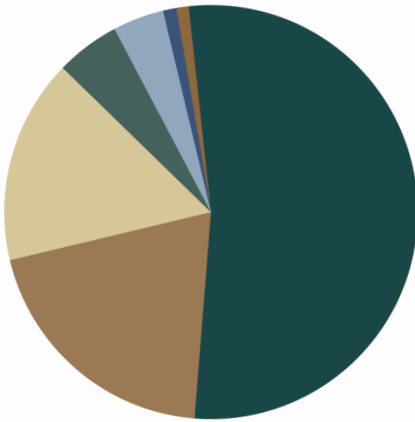

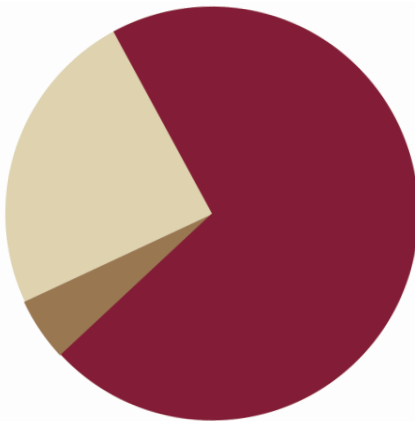
