## HOW TO REGISTER

Registration will be handled on a group basis, and forms can be downloaded from the website: [www.RespectLifeChicago.org](http://www.RespectLifeChicago.org) or email [rpingoy@archchicago.org](mailto:rpingoy@archchicago.org). These forms may be copied as needed. Individual applicants who are interested in attending may contact office for assistance in joining a group. Registration and Final Payment Deadline is on **December 9, 2016**. A 50% deposit for each group will be required and collected in advance to reserve spots on the trip. Space is limited. Don't wait until the last minute!

## CHAPERONES AND ADULTS

We request that groups provide at least 1 chaperone for every 10 teens. But groups with less than 10 teens must have 2 adult chaperones. It is a policy of the Archdiocese of Chicago that every adult must be Virtus Trained and complete an on-line background check as well as a DCFS/CANTS background check. All of the requirements should be completed through the local parish or school under which your group is representing. A "Safe Environment Acknowledgement Form" is required to be filled out, signed, and turned in per group. This form can be downloaded and printed from [www.RespectLifeChicago.org](http://www.RespectLifeChicago.org) or request a copy by emailing: [rpingoy@archchicago.org](mailto:rpingoy@archchicago.org). Chaperones should be someone from the group. (*i.e. a Teacher, Principal, Priest, Youth Minister or Parent.*)

All Participants registered to join this Archdiocesan Pilgrimage must follow the official schedule set by the Archdiocese of Chicago Office of Human Dignity and Solidarity.

So join the Archdiocese of Chicago as we March for Life!

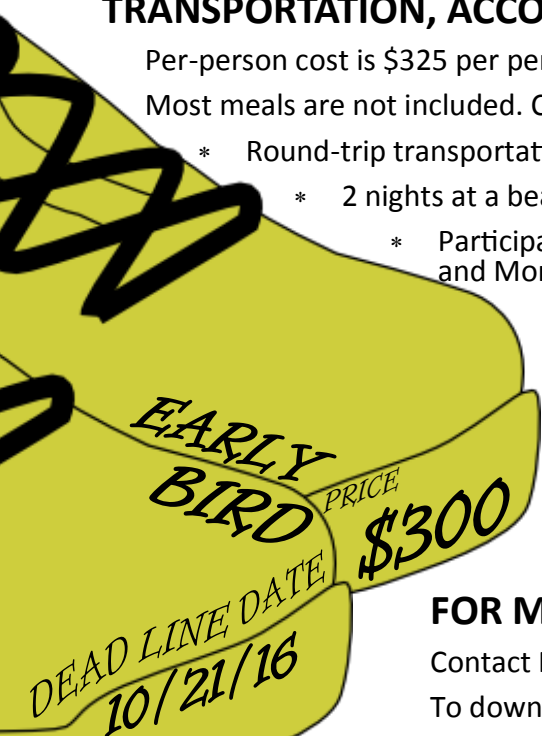
## TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE EARLY BIRD RATE!
